## Other

- In 2017, Mr. Kremlev initiated the establishment of a public holiday — the Russian Boxing Day on July 22. The first celebration was marked by an achievement entered the Guinness Book of Records: about three thousand people took part in an open training session on Red Square in Moscow
- In 2019, the International Boxing Association recognized the holiday, and it became to be celebrated worldwide
- In 2021, the International Boxing Day was rescheduled to August 27th due to the dates of the first AIBA World Boxing Championships in 1974 in Havana
- Mr. Kremlev is actively engaged into charitable activities. For example, under his leadership the Russian Boxing Federation organized a large-scale campaign during the period of restrictive measures due to the coronavirus providing support to athletes, senior citizens, large families, veterans etc.
