IBA World Championships

The IBA World Boxing Championships stands as the premier international tournament organized by the International Boxing Association (IBA), where elite boxers from across the globe vie for the esteemed title of World Champion in separate male and female competition. This prestigious event occurs biennially and is renowned for showcasing intense skill, athleticism, and the highest level of amateur boxing talent across various weight categories. With athletes from over 100 countries participating, the Championships have become one of the most anticipated events in the sport. It serves as a vital platform for both emerging talents and growing IBA professionals, setting the stage for our athletes while also cementing both foundation and legacies within the IBA Boxing Family. We look forward to hosting the 2025 male edition in Asia.

Education and Development

Over the past 24 months, IBA has successfully delivered **more than 40 courses across ASBC**, highlighting a significant commitment to educational growth within the continent. With continued support from Asia, the organization has maintained a prominent level of expertise, ensuring that the quality of training and education remains intact. This dedication has not only enriched the knowledge base of coaches and officials but has also played a crucial role in supporting athletes. The valued work of both IBA and ASBC has contributed to the success of numerous boxers competing at the highest levels of the sport, reinforcing the importance of education in fostering sporting excellence.

Financial Support Programme (FSP)

Furthermore, IBA provides immense support to both athletes and National Federations, which currently cannot be provided by any other organization.

In May 2021, the International Boxing Association (IBA) launched a pioneering Financial Support Programme (FSP) aimed at developing, supporting, and strengthening boxing across all levels, including grassroots initiatives. This program seeks to enhance the independence, efficiency, and transparency of management, government, and administrative systems to meet future development needs. IBA reserves funds of up to \$20,000 for each National Federation, ensuring that financial resources are available to foster growth in the sport. Through the FSP, the IBA provides significant assistance to athletes who require support in attending major tournaments (both IBA and Olympic), while also facilitating the organization of boxing events. This dual approach not only generates greater interest in the sport but also helps to identify and nurture new talent, ensuring a vibrant future for boxing.

On 4 May 2024, the IBA Board of Directors at the meeting in Madrid approved the comprehensive event roadmap for 2024-2028. IBA is investing over **\$80 million into prize money** over the next four-year cycle until 2028. The prize money fund for the IBA Men's World Boxing Championships is set at **\$10.4 million** per event, and the IBA Women's Boxing Championships is set **\$4.8 million** per event. Said investments also include the **prize money for Continental Championships**.

In addition, IBA has allocated **\$500,000 prize money fund** for medalists and quarterfinalists of the <u>ASBC Asian Boxing Championships</u> that will take place in Chiang Mai, Thailand from 28 November – 12 December 2024.

The final element to this will be the continental support directly managed to the ASBC office in the form of **\$500,000 financial support** that we will also go some way towards the development of boxing across Asia.

Summary

In conclusion, whilst we understand the current issues we face, along with the extremely challenging environment in our sport, this narrative serves as a timely reminder of the positive impact that IBA has had on its members. The support provided by the **IBA together with ASBC** has been invaluable, contributing to a sense of community and cooperation among its members. We appreciate the continued contribution and dedication of all participants, as it strengthens our collective efforts for the future.
