**Based on Art. 4 of the Boxing Independent Integrity Unit Procedural Rules,
the Boxing Independent Integrity Unit's Managing Director,
on 7 January 2025,
decides what follows.**

1. The complaint dated 22 November 2024 is not admissible for being obviously unsuitable, and it is therefore written off.
2. The decision goes without stating reasons.
3. No procedural costs are imposed.
4. The complainant bears its own possible costs incurred by the complaint.
5. The decision is notified to the complainant by email.
